He is a member of the UN International Law Commission and its Special Rapporteur on Peremptory Norms of General International Law (*Jus Cogens*). He is also a member of the *Institut de Droit International*. He was formerly Special Adviser to the South African Foreign Minister and has also been legal adviser to the South African Foreign Ministry and the Legal Counsel to the South African Mission to the United Nations in New York.
